The 2012 historical drama, "A Royal Affair" was directed by Nikolaj Arcel starring Mads Mikkelsen, Alicia Vikander and Mikkel Følsgaard.


Nature Bathing

Scandinavians spend a uniquely large amount of time in nature - walking, trekking, running, skiing, swimming, camping, orienteering, playing, and a lot of other assortments of outdoor pursuits. There are even child care operations that do not have an indoor facility, but are based on year-round outdoor activities!

Similarly, the Japanese describe it as 'nature bathing' (*shinrin-yoku*) - the immersion into nature, which improves cerebral blood flow, increased immune defense, and improved mental health.

Central Ohio has many city and state parks, and other green spaces, that provide opportunities for getting in touch with Mother Nature, and the autumn months are an inspiring time to get out and explore. It's a core component of our Nordic heritage - and so good for you!

Small Kingdom of Denmark

Although often thought of as a "small kingdom", Denmark is the 12th largest nation in the world. In terms of geographic size, it's bigger than Germany, Turkey, and France — combined.

A large portion of that surprising size is Greenland. Although technically part of North America, Greenland is a semiautonomous country in the Kingdom of Denmark.

Norway, Sweden, and Denmark united under the Danes in 1397, and Greenland became a Danish possession. When the union of Denmark and Norway ended in 1814, Greenland remained a Danish colony.

A new Danish constitution, adopted in 1953, changed Greenland's status from a colony to a country of Denmark. Meanwhile, Greenlanders think of independence as eventually inevitable. In 2008, three-quarters of Greenlanders voted for significantly more autonomy and Denmark has since relinquished its claim to the country's natural resources. With the ability to control its own resources, Greenland's prime minister told the Financial Times that Greenland could become financially independent of Denmark "easily within my lifetime." Whether the country takes the step toward actual independence, however, remains to be seen. In the meantime, Denmark remains one of the world's largest nation-states.
